Dear Colleague,

At the October meeting of the SMSNA, the society is facilitating a meeting between Fastsize LLC and a panel of SMSNA Peyronie's Disease researchers.

The purpose of the meeting is to discuss a national research initiative on Peyronie's Disease and penile traction therapy. This is in response to the results of a recent clinical trial that I conducted with support from Fastsize LLC. The results allow us to be cautiously optimistic about the potential for traction therapy to reduce the deformities associated with Peyronie's Disease.

The national research initiative will encourage physicians across the US to participate in further large-scale research by using a new protocol incorporating the use of traction for the treatment of Peyronie's, and then reporting the results to a central data base. Each year this information will be reviewed by a SMSNA advisory panel, and a paper will be presented at SMSNA meetings. Preliminary organization and management of the program will be provided by Mark Newell PhD of the Medway Research Institute, a SMSNA member, and also a consultant to Fastsize. Fastsize will fund the costs of creating and maintaining the database.

Fastsize is a California company and I would like to encourage this national research effort by asking my California based colleagues to be among the first to consider participation. Your proximity to the company in Aliso Viejo could facilitate troubleshooting and development of the data base.

Mark Newell will be in the Los Angeles area September 24th, 25th and 27th, and I would appreciate it if you could make time to meet with him for a brief explanation of the program in advance of the October SMSNA meeting in Toronto. I will update you on the results of the meeting immediately after returning from Toronto.
